

Loren Mosher M.D., Harvardtrained psychiatrist and author of 100+ scientific publications, founded the Soteria Project, a non-drug, home-like, residential recovery facility for schizophrenics. Soteria proved the effectiveness of alternatives to toxic medication. Because it threatened pharmaceutical company profits, Soteria was shut down and Mosher was fired from the NIMH. He resigned from the American Psychiatric Association, saying that it had become indistinguishable from the American Pharmacological Association.
