

Feminist psychologist, author, and whistleblower Paula Caplan challenges the American Psychiatric Association to prove that the diagnostic labels in its Diagnostic and Statistical Manual (DSM) are based on real science and not just the subjective biases of a few rich white men. Caplan has written more than 8 books including They Say You're Crazy: How The World's Most Powerful Psychiatrists Decide Who's Normal, the Myth of Woman's Masochism, and Bias in Psychiatric Diagnoses.
